- IV. Information items from the Principal:**
 - A. Personnel - Many positions for the 25-25 school year have been filled with highly recommended new teachers. There are still 3 positions currently available.
 - B. Financial/Resource Allocation - All state and federal funds have been spent on necessities benefitting the students. We are beginning to plan for our first fundraiser of next year, the pre-game supper.
 - C. Curriculum Instruction - New ELA standards are in the process of being learned by teachers and will be implemented during the 2025-26 school year. CCS has adopted a new math curriculum with the new math standards for the 2024-25 school year. Teachers are in the process of receiving professional development with this curriculum.
 - D. Achievement of School Improvement Goals - Dr. Purvis reviewed current EOY MAP data and discipline data. WJW has 2 SIP goals. One based on achievement growth as measured by GMAS and the other to decrease the number of major discipline referrals. According to EOY MAP data, we are on track to meet our achievement growth goals. Our number of major discipline referrals is on track to decrease by more than 20% which exceeds our goal.
 - E. School Operations - Construction is underway. Teacher rooms are relocating this year. Only those that are moving to the new building will have to relocate the following year.
