### EARN REWARDS WITH HEALTH SCREENINGS



Preventive screenings are always a good idea; they can alert you to health issues before they become a bigger concern.

In 2023, if you (or your eligible spouse) complete one of the included preventive screening exams (colonoscopy, mammogram, pap smear or prostate screening) prior to September 30, your Sharecare account will automatically be rewarded 60 points for each exam. You can earn up to a maximum of 120 points for two completed preventive screening exams.

Please make sure you have created your Sharecare/Be Well SHBP account and completed the RealAge® Test for 2023. Follow these steps to start earning rewards:

- If you have never registered for an account on [BeWellSHBP.com](http://BeWellSHBP.com), register here; if you already have an account, use your email and password to log in here.
- Take the RealAge Test for 2023 to activate your account and earn 120 points. The RealAge Test needs to be updated each year, so even if you completed this assessment in 2022, you would need to update it for 2023.

After earning points, you can choose to redeem your points for well-being incentive credits (which can be done in increments of 120); or redeem all 480 points for a \$150 Sharecare Rewards Visa® Prepaid Card.
