Our district has an excellent relationship with the Colquitt County Sheriff's Office and Moultrie Police Department, and Mr. Edgar will work with them in his new role. 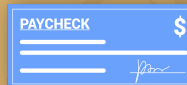

### MAP - PUTTING THE DATA TO WORK



The MAP **Learning Continuum** provides teachers with information regarding what content students likely need to be reinforced, developed, or introduced. Paired with formative assessments, the information on the **Learning Continuum** and the students' **RIT** scores are vital tools in accelerating learning.

Teachers may access the **Learning Continuum** from the **NWEA** site by logging in and choosing **View Reports>MAP Reports>Learning Continuum** and opening either **Class View** or **Test View**.
