UPCOMING ACCREDITATION

Over the next year, the Colquitt County School District will embark on renewing its accreditation credential with COGNIA (formerly known as AdvancED, SACS, and CASI). COGNIA has updated the performance standards by which they support a school system's improvement over time through a peer review process.

CULTURE OF LEARNING - WHAT IT MEANS

A good institution nurtures and sustains a healthy culture for learning. In a healthy culture, learners, parents, and educators feel connected to the purpose and work of the institution as well as behave in alignment with the stated values and norms. The institution also demonstrates evidence that reflects the mission, beliefs, and expectations of the institution (e.g., student work; physical appearance of the institution; participation in institution activities; parents' attendance at institution functions).

- STANDARD 1 Leaders cultivate and sustain a culture that demonstrates respect, fairness, equity, and inclusion and is free from bias.
- STANDARD 2 Learners' well-being is at the heart of the institution's guiding principles, such as mission, purpose, and beliefs
- STANDARD 3 Leaders actively engage stakeholders to support the institution's priorities and guiding principles that promote learners' academic growth and well-being.
- **STANDARD 4** Learners benefit from a formal structure that fosters positive relationships with peers and adults.
- STANDARD 5 Professional staff members embrace effective collegiality and collaboration in support of learners.
- **STANDARD 6** Professional staff members receive the support they need to strengthen their professional practice.

Former Governor Nathan Deal launched REACH in 2012 as a key initiative of Complete College Georgia. School systems partner with REACH and identify academically promising eighth-grade students to receive REACH Scholarships. Scholars are paired with a mentor and an academic coach through high school. Scholars must maintain good grades (2.5 GPA), behavior, and attendance. Upon graduation from high school, scholars are awarded a \$10,000 scholarship to be used at a Georgia HOPE-eligible two- or four-year college. Some colleges have pledged to double or triple the scholarship for REACH Scholars.
