Over the next year, the Colquitt County School District will embark on renewing its accreditation credential with COGNIA. COGNIA has updated the performance standards by which they support a school system's improvement over time through a peer review process.

GROWTH IN LEARNING - WHAT IT MEANS

A good institution positively impacts learners throughout their journey of learning. A positive impact on the learner is reflected in readiness to engage in and preparedness for the next transition in their learning. Growth in learning is also reflected in learners' ability to meet expectations in knowledge and skill acquisition.

- **STANDARD 24** - Leaders use data and input from a variety of sources to make decisions for learners' and staff members' growth and well-being.
- **STANDARD 25** - Leaders promote action research by professional staff members to improve their practice and advance learning.
