UPCOMING ACCREDITATION

As part of the CCSD's 2024-2025 Cognia Accreditation Review, students, parents, and personnel will complete surveys during the month of April to report on experiences and perceptions in classrooms, schools, and the district. Employees who are also parents should complete both the parent and personnel surveys so the district captures as much feedback as possible.

A link to the personnel survey will be provided through email after Spring Break. Students in grades 3-12 and all parents will complete the survey during the month of April.

EARN REWARDS WITH HEALTH SCREENINGS

Preventive screenings are always a good idea; they can alert you to health issues before they become a more significant concern.


In 2024, if you (or your eligible spouse) complete one of the included preventive screening exams (colonoscopy, mammogram, pap smear, or prostate screening) before September 30, your Sharecare account will automatically be rewarded 60 points for each exam. You can earn up to 120 points for two completed preventive screening exams.

Please make sure you have created your Sharecare/Be Well SHBP account and completed the RealAge® Test for 2024. Follow these steps to start earning rewards:

- If you have never registered for an account on BeWellSHBP.com, register here; if you already have an account, use your email and password to log in here.
- Take the RealAge Test for 2024 to activate your account and earn 120 points. The RealAge Test needs to be updated each year, so even if you completed this assessment in 2023, you would need to update it for 2024.

After earning points, you can choose to redeem your points for well-being incentive credits (which can be done in increments of 120) or redeem all 480 points for a \$150 Sharecare Rewards Visa® Prepaid Card. More details can be found at **BeWellSHBP.com**.com or by calling 888.616.6411.
