#### Phase Two: Interview and Records Check

Dr. Cross, Mrs. McLean, or Mrs. Moon will schedule an appointment for you. Students who are considered for the program will be evaluated by grades, attendance, and discipline records. Problems with grades, attendance, discipline or an unfavorable recommendation from a teacher may disqualify you from being accepted. Students will be emailed with decision letters.

NOTE TO STUDENT: The goal of the WBL program is to attract quality students to the workplace with competent and skilled workers and further transition students into education opportunities and career paths.

#### **Qualifications for WBL:**

- Must be 16 years of age
- On Track for Graduation
- No Disciplinary Action (We look back a year)
- Less than 10 unexcused absences per semester. (We look back a year)
- Completed a Pathway (Class of 2026 and after)
- Passed the End of Pathway Exam. (Class of 2026 and after)
