GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Class of 2023, 2024, and 2025: Students must earn a total of 23 credits to graduate from CCHS.

These credits must include certain courses and subjects. Although, most students will ultimately earn more than 23 credits by the end of their senior year. Requirements are as follows:

- 4 English: 9th Grade Literature and Composition; American Literature and Composition
- 4 Math: Algebra I; Geometry; Algebra II
- 4 Science: Biology; Physical Science or Physics; Environmental Science or Chemistry
- 3 Social Studies: World History; U. S. History; Economics (1/2 credit); American Government (1/2 credit)
- 3 CTAE/Fine Arts/World Language*
- 1 PE: Personal Fitness and Health
- 4 Electives

Class of 2026 and beyond: Students must earn a total of 24 credits AND complete a CTAE, World Language, Advanced Academic, and/or Fine Arts Pathway.

- 4 English: 9th Grade Literature and Composition; American Literature and Composition
- 4 Math: Algebra I; Geometry; Algebra II
- 4 Science: Biology; Physical Science or Physics; Environmental Science or Chemistry
- 4 Social Studies: World History; U. S. History; Economics; American Government
- 3 CTAE/Fine Arts/World Language*
- 1 PE: Personal Fitness and Health
- 4 Electives
- * Students planning to enter or transfer into a University System of Georgia Institution must take a minimum of two units of the same World Language.

Students can track their graduation progress using the Academic (graduation) Planner in Infinite Campus or a Transcript Evaluation Form. They can also ask their guidance counselor for a paper copy of both forms. This will help map out their next 3-4 years of high school.
