Agricultural and Rural Services Committee Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Recipient must be a graduating senior residing in or attending school in Colquitt County with a B average or higher.
- 2. Recipient must enter a post-secondary school or college majoring in the fields of agriculture, agribusiness or Ag education after graduation.
- 3. A copy of confirmed enrollment by a school official at the post-secondary institution showing field of study must be submitted to the Chamber's Ag & Rural Services Committee before payment of scholarship will be distributed. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- 4. The scholarship may be applied toward tuition, room and board, books and supplies, or any other education-related expenses.
- 5. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded this year made payable to the college.
- 6. Application Deadline: Second Friday in February, at 12:00 pm (noon).
