**Agricultural and Rural Services Committee
Scholarship Guidelines**

1. Recipient must be a graduating senior residing in or attending school in Colquitt County with a B average or higher.
2. Recipient must enter a post-secondary school or college majoring in the fields of agriculture, agribusiness or Ag education after graduation.
3. A copy of confirmed enrollment by a school official at the post-secondary institution showing field of study must be submitted to the Chamber’s Ag & Rural Services Committee before payment of scholarship will be distributed. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
4. The scholarship may be applied toward tuition, room and board, books and supplies, or any other education-related expenses.
5. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded this year made payable to the college.
6. Application Deadline: Second Friday in February, at 12:00 pm (noon).
