

## **Becky Bevacqua Scholarship**

The Becky Bevacqua Scholarship is a scholarship awarded in the memory of Becky Bevacqua, an English teacher in Colquitt County Schools for 17 years.

### **Scholarship Qualifications:**

The Becky Bevacqua Scholarship is awarded annually to one student who meets the following criteria:

- Student has taken advanced/AP English classes for 3-4 years
- Student has a GPA of 3.5 or above
- Student has been involved in extracurricular activities at CCHS and in the community, and has held a leadership position in at least one of these

Preferred but not required criteria:

- Student is a member of the National Honor Society
- Student is applying to schools outside the state of Georgia

### **Scholarship Award:**

The recipient of the scholarship will receive \$500 a year for 4 years to be used for tuition, room/board or books during that academic year. The award recipient will be notified at CCHS Honors Night.

### **Applications:**

To apply, students must complete the following application and essay.
