  - 1. Please complete the following pages and submit with the required documents.
  - An essay of 500 words maximum must accompany this application. The essay must be typed and double-spaced. Applicant's essay must reflect his/her community activities and tell how he/she feels these experiences have prepared him/her for life. It should also reflect why community service is important.
  - 3. Detailed list of community service activities occurring within the past two years.
  - 4. Three letters of recommendation, one from a school official and two from other sources.
  - 5. A copy of applicant's transcripts including a statement of explanation. This information will assist us in interpreting your transcripts
  - 6. Statement of financial need-Financial need will be reviewed, but the overriding criteria will be community service involvement. Circle one number that best describes your financial need with 1 being the lowest need and 10 being the most need.
