The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Nelms.

Members said the pledge of allegiance.

Roll call was completed. Members present were Mrs. Nelms, Mrs. Cardin, Mr. Cohran, Mr. Joel Jenkins, and Mrs. Bailey

Mrs. Cardin read the minutes from the last meeting. Mr. Cohran made a motion to approve and Mrs. Bailey seconded.

We have reviewed all of the LSGT modules. Mrs. Nelms reminded members that the modules were available through the link on the agenda.

The ELA curriculum adoption was reviewed. Mrs. Nelms explained that CARES money would be purchasing the new curriculum. My View was approved as the new ELA curriculum at the March Board of Education meeting. My View will be providing an abundance of resources and support to guide teachers as they begin using the new curriculum. Teachers will have access to a My View representative once a month to support lesson planning and implementation.

The new Math ELA curriculum adoption began in March. Teachers attended a standard crosswalk of new and old standards. The district has chosen six curriculums for teachers to look at. By the end of May two curriculums will be eliminated. A group of teachers will attend a meeting to dive into the remaining four curriculum. After meeting the teachers will narrow down the choices to two curriculums. Teachers will have from August to February to work with the remaining two curriculums. A final curriculum will be voted on by Spring of 2023.

Mrs. Nelms reviewed testing coming up. Students kindergarten through fifth grade will participate in MAP testing April 25-29. Students in grades three through five will participate in GMAS May 2-9. Third and fourth graders will take math and reading on the GMAS. Fifth grade students will take reading, math, and science. In order to maintain points on the CCRPI we will need 95% participation on the GMAS. Attendance incentives will be give students who participate in all testing. Daily treats will be given as well as a big end of the week surprise.

Mrs. Nelms reviewed carry over funds. A Saturday GMAS academy will be provided for students taking the GMAS. Students will be allowed to attend the four hour sessions on 3 Saturdays in April 2022. Money has been allocated to the library to purchase books. Next school year Solution Tree will provide a coach to guide teachers on the PLC process. The leadership team will participate in a retreat this summer.

The administrative team is working on filling open positions. Stringfellow will receive two more separate classes and one inclusion pre-kindergarten class.

Mrs. Nelms thanked the members for participating in the Local School Governance team.

Mr. Cohran motioned to close the meeting. Mrs. Bailey seconded the motion.
