 - A. Personnel - We are currently seeking a certified special education teacher.
 - B. Financial/Resource Allocation - We have spent half of our QBE funds. Dr. Purvis explained the different types of funding to the team. We have a Coca-Cola fundraiser this month. We hope to raise money on this fundraiser that will be spent on resources and incentives for students and teachers.
 - C. Curriculum Instruction - We just finished our 2nd unit of instruction. We formed remediation/acceleration groups based on the data from this assessment. Dr. Purvis reviewed our MAP data from the previous school year and the beginning of this school year. He also reviewed the GMAS data for our school compared with our RESA for the 22-23 school year.
 - D. Achievement of School Improvement Goals - WJW has 2 SIP goals. One based on achievement growth as measured by GMAS and the other to decrease the number of major discipline referrals. According to our BOY MAP assessment, we are beginning at a higher level overall this year. The goal is to make growth and not stay stagnant. Our number of major discipline referrals decreased by 100 when compared to the number of referrals in August of last year.
