Information Items from Principal

A. Personnel

 Positions that need to be filled for next year are 4 Reading/ELA, 1 Special Ed, and 2 Social Studies. After interviews yesterday, we are now down to 2 ELA positions.

B. Lost Positions

 We have lost ½ counselor position, an ESOL Translator, and a Math Support. The Math Support position was lost to gain a Social Studies position. The translator position lost due to federal funding being cut and our district is not able to fund it. This will hurt us next year with the increase in students for the 2018-2019 school year. We will have 29-30% increase Hispanic population. We will also add 75-100 more students.

C. Budget Requests

• Long Cafeteria Tables-Will purchase at least half of the tables this year and other half next year. The tables will hopefully be here in May.

D. Lock Down Procedures

- Dr. Horne explained the we will have regular drills next year.
- We will notify students of when we will do it.

E. GMAS

- Georgia Milestone Assessment has been completed.
- ALl test were taken on computers except 3 were taken on paper due to 504's or other special circumstances.
- There were a few minor issues but overall was successful.
- Every so often some students were kicked out, but were able to log back in and continue.
- No major testing discrepancies.

F. Final Exams

- Finals will be in May.
- Finals count for 5% of their grade.

G. Attendance

- Has been better this year.
- Attendance is one item we scored low on school climate. We have worked hard to improve this.

H. School Climate Ratings

- We are hoping for a 4 this year.
- Mr. Craft asked what the school climate means? Dr. Horne explained that it means a lot to the outside world. It comes down with CCRPI. State pulls data. It can be accessed from the Georgia DOE webpage.

I. Discipline Issues

- Mr. Southwell reported that discipline has increased due to Milestone being over.
- Habitual Offenders will soon be sent home with ROY-Rest of Year.
- Teachers know to keep students engaged in preparing them for finals.
