

Items for Action by Local School Governance Team

 - Modules have been emailed to all members and are on website.
 - Dr. Home gave an overview of modules and bylaws. Modules and bylaws for K-12. 6-12 are aligned together.

Information Items from Principal

- A. Personnel
 - Our faculty has had to deal with some family deaths-Tonya Davidson (registrar) mother, which is also Aisha Parsons (front office) grandmother passed away, Choir teacher Jimbo Jarvis father in law passed away unexpectedly, Mr. Southwell grandfather passed away, and Ms. Helen Farrell brother is expected to pass any time.
 - Spanish Teacher -still in search of Spanish teacher, cannot find one who has the qualifications. Brad Ruis will remain in that position. We will be reposting the position on the district website.
- B. REACH Scholarship Program

- Willie J will be hosting the signing ceremony for the 2017 REACH Scholars on October 4, 2017 at 10 AM in the gym. We are trying to get the school decorated and ready for this program. First Lady Sandra Deal will be in attendance to speak on behalf of Gov. Deal's REACH program. Each recipient was nominated as a 7th grader in 2016-2017 school year. The main qualification is that they have to be the the first in their family to attend college after high school graduation. Each REACH Scholar will receive \$10,000 to put towards their college education, providing they meet the program requirements.
- Current 7th graders will be in attendance to witness the signing.

C. Academic Coach

- Willie J has Leah Johnston as our Academic Coach. She is to help in the classroom; she is not doing evaluations on teachers. She is here as an added tool to help our teachers and students be successful.

D. Curriculum News/ELT

- Mrs. Harrison discussed ELT Reading and Math. Both are geared to student success. Reading ELT is Wednesdays. Students are grouped based on Lexiles into Reciprocal, PALS, or Phonics. Math ELT is on Thursdays. Students are grouped based on 1,2,3,4 Math ELT is starting to go smoothly; students and teachers are getting equipped to it.
- Mrs. Harrison explained our Data Management Tool called Illuminate. This is an online tool that teachers can track student's progress. It is linked to standards in Reading, Math and ELA, and some standards in Science and Social Studies. Test can be made in this program and students then test online with Chromebooks.
- In all curriculums, reading and writing are being pushed to help students be successful.

E. School Improvement

- Floors are being done in the conference room. Hopefully will be finished and meetings can take place in the conference room in the future.

F. School Operations

- All teachers received a nice printable that listed the schools Non-Negotiables: Be On Time, No Social Media during school hours, dress for success, student supervision, teamwork, zip your lip, be prepared, and be present.
- Teachers are reminded of the video that the PAGE attorney.

G. Discipline Issues

- One student brought a taser to school.
- At a recent football game, a student passed around a gun.
- Both incidents were dealt with appropriately.
