### <u>Information items from the Principal:</u>

**Personnel-** Currently we have two open positions; one Gen Ed and one Speed. The Gen Ed position will be filled by a current employee who will graduate and be certified in December. Search continues for someone to fill the Sped position.

**Financial/Resource/Allocation-**We are currently awaiting our title monies to be approved. Most money was spent on resources for the classroom, including subscriptions, 300 headphones, and payment for our 2023 summer school coordinator, Mr. Ketchum.

General funds- We will not have a school-wide fundraiser as many teams have fundraisers for their teams' specific needs. Our first fundraiser for the year is for VIP Parent Parking. Instead of waiting in the long car pick-up line, there will be a privileged parking spot to pull in for the remainder of the year. Ticket prices are five dollars. We will possibly sponsor a silent cake auction.

**Curriculum Instruction-** MAP is an adaptive test to determine a student's instructional level. Our goal is to progress them one year's growth during the school year. The test is taken 3 times a year: August, December, and May. Students and teachers are meeting to set their goals. If goals are met, their names are put in a raffle to win airpods. The goal is to encourage self-motivation regarding their personal academic growth.

The Department of Education will be here on 11/10/22. Because our performance of content mastery declined significantly by 16-18 points this past year, a team will come in, meet with both teachers and students, observe, and review our policies and procedures and provide feedback for school improvement. This is an outside pair of eyes to look at what we are doing to give information on ways to reverse the decline.

A brand new ELA curriculum, My Perspectives, has been implemented this year. The program offers a plethora of resources. As with anything new, this first year is about learning all the content and how to most effectively use it. The ELA teachers are confident this will be a tool to help our students achieve academic success.

Also, with the bridge from elementary-they have adopted the same curriculumwe anticipate students will be better prepared when they enter middle school. Our goal is to increase GA Milestones by three percent in both math and ELA.

Tier 3 Intervention- Read 180 - This is a program for students entering middle school 2-3 years below reading level. Many of these students have 'holes' in their academic learning, and this program effectively fills in the gaps for those students who work the program. As of today, 3 month into the school year, 30% of students have met their end-of-the-year goal.

### **Achievement of School Improvement Goals-**

Goal 1: By the end of the 22-23 school year, WJW will increase CCRPI content mastery by 3% on ELA/math GMAS.

Goal 2: By the end of the 22-23 school year, WJW will decrease the percentage of discipline referrals by 5%.

Goal 3: By the end of the 22-23 school year, WJW will increase stakeholder involvement.

**School Operations-** Different activities for students meeting their goals; career fair; science fair; December will be a busy 3 weeks.

District's new Safety Operations person will come around to view our practices and help us achieve and maintain the safest campus possible.

Exterior doors remain locked during the school day.

There is no longer outside to change classes.
