What is Title 1?

What is it?

How is it developed?

Who is it for? All students participating in the Title 1, part A school-wide program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Willie J will provide full opportunities for participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available? At the beginning of the year, the plan is included in the student handbook that is given to all students. The plan will also be posted on the school website. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the Parent resource center (Front office).

2023-2024 District Goals:

- By the end of 23-24 school year, the CCSS will increase student achievement as measured by the GMAS by 3%
- By the end of the 23-24 school year, the CCSS will use the FY23 percentage data to decrease the percentage of students who miss more than 10 school days by 3%

2023-2024 School Goals:

- By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, increase student achievement in all academic areas, specifically improving the student growth percentile level by 5%
- By the end of the 23-24 school year, Willie J will decrease the achievement gap in proficiency between the lowest performing subgroups and highest as measured by GMAS by 5%.

School Parent Compact:

The parents, students and school staff developed the school compact. The teachers suggested home learning strategies, parents added ideas to make them more specific, and students told us what would help them learn. An Annual revision meeting is held each year to review the compact and make changes based upon the needs of students.
